#### **1. 2<sup>ND</sup> LOCAL TRANSPORT PLAN AND TRANSPORT VISION**

Councillor Hussain welcomed all attendees and gave a brief introduction into the purpose of the seminar.

Members were given two presentations on the final stage of the development of LTP2 and the development of a longer term Transport Vision.

It was reported that consultants, Arups, had been appointed to provide assistance on the vision and had undertaken initial work to define key transport requirements to support future economic growth. Their representatives, Richard Higgins and Ian Mobbs facilitated a consultation workshop for members' views to be considered as part of the development of the vision.

It was reported that the vision would set out how West Yorkshire's transport network should develop to be 'fit for purpose' to support economic growth in the sub-region in a sustainable way that maximises accessibility for all. It would be unconstrained by Government guidance and funding and would be submitted with the final Local Transport Plan in March 2006.
