## SUBJECT: CONSULTATION ITEMS

### Report of the Passenger Transport Executive

#### 1. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 1.1. PCC members views on ways to make better use of public transport capacity.

#### 2. INFORMATION

- 2.1. PCC members have been consulted on various aspects of the second West Yorkshire Local Transport Plan, including the Bus Strategy and RailPlan 6.
- 2.2. A common theme to these is how to make better use of public transport capacity, including increasing off-peak rail use, evening and Sunday bus use and encouraging commuters to travel at different times in order to reduce over-crowding, particularly on peak trains to Leeds.
- 2.3. Initiatives adopted elsewhere (and to an extent in West Yorkshire) include fares policies, off-peak promotion and flexible work practices.
- 2.4. There will be a short-presentation to the meeting to highlight some of the issues.
- 2.5. PCC members will be invited to comment and make suggestions for future action.

#### 3. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1. That PCC Members provide feedback following a brief presentation.
